

Does MY file need to be optimized?

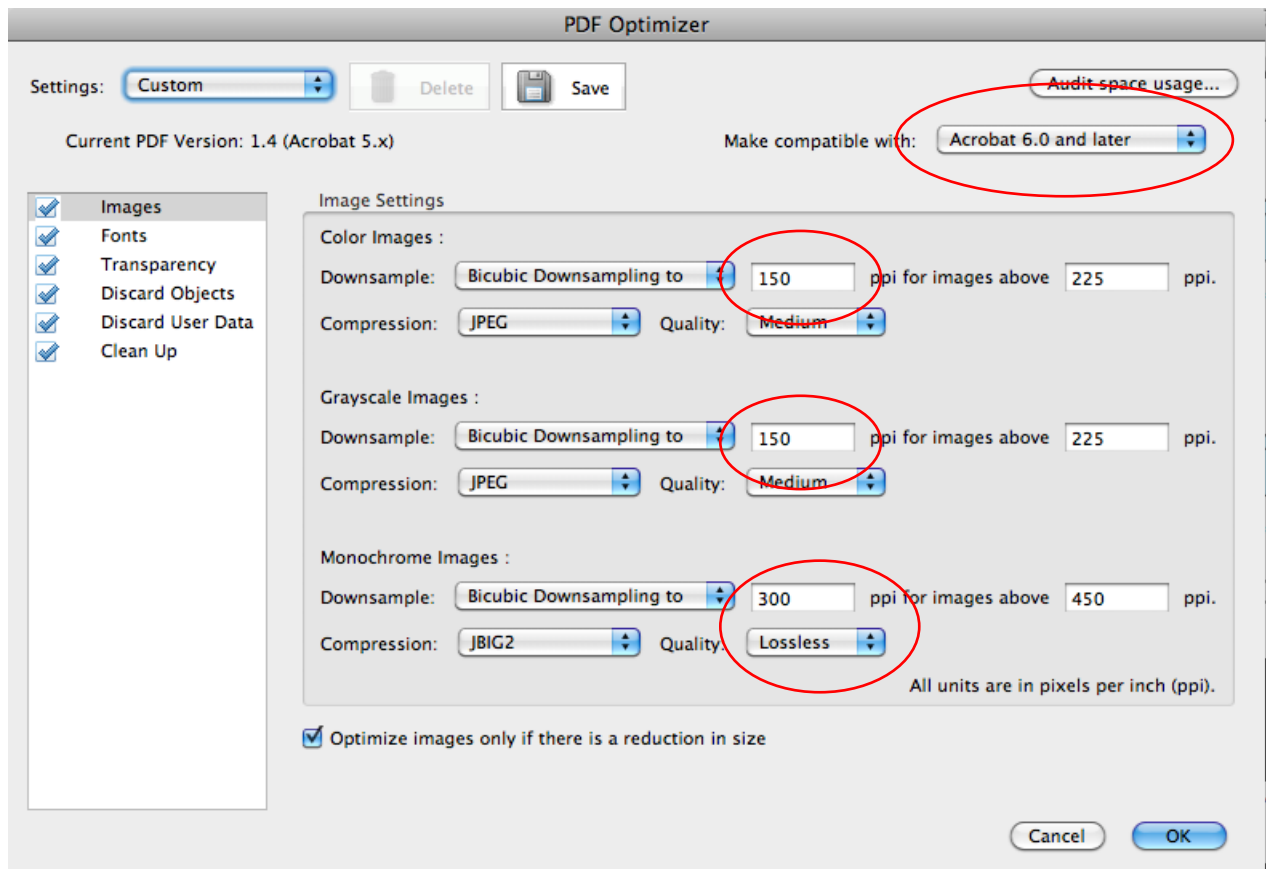
If your file takes a long time to load onscreen—YES

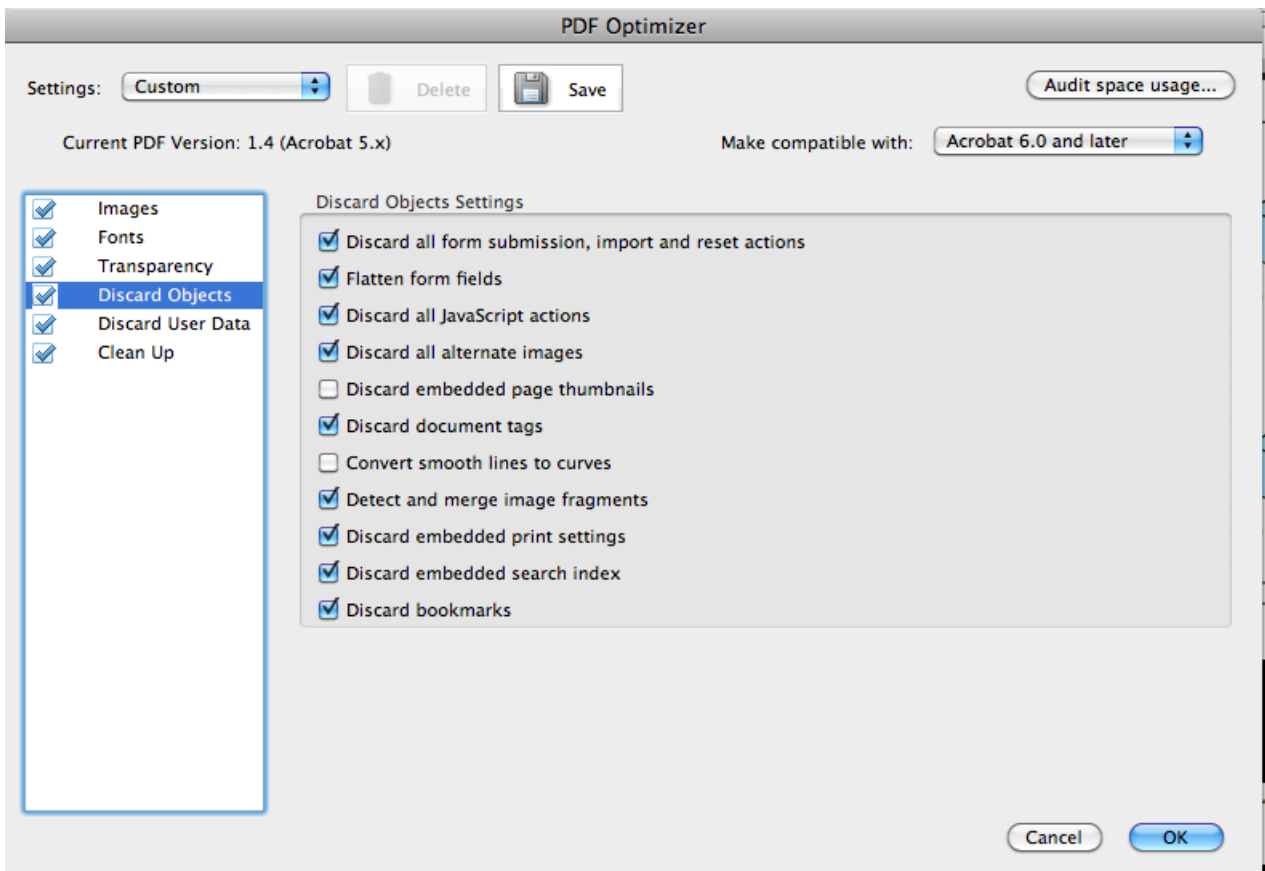
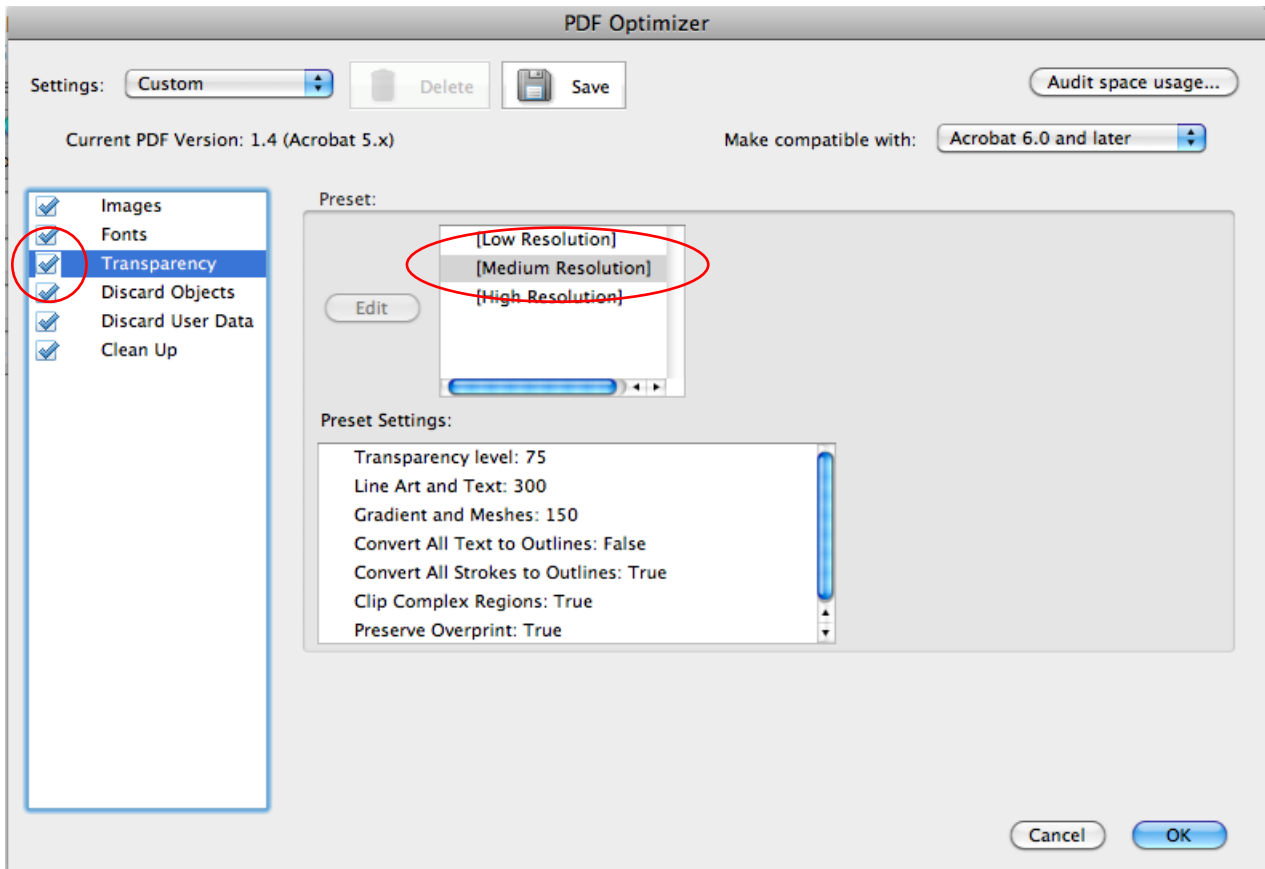
If your PDF contains layers, transparency, and high resolution images—YES

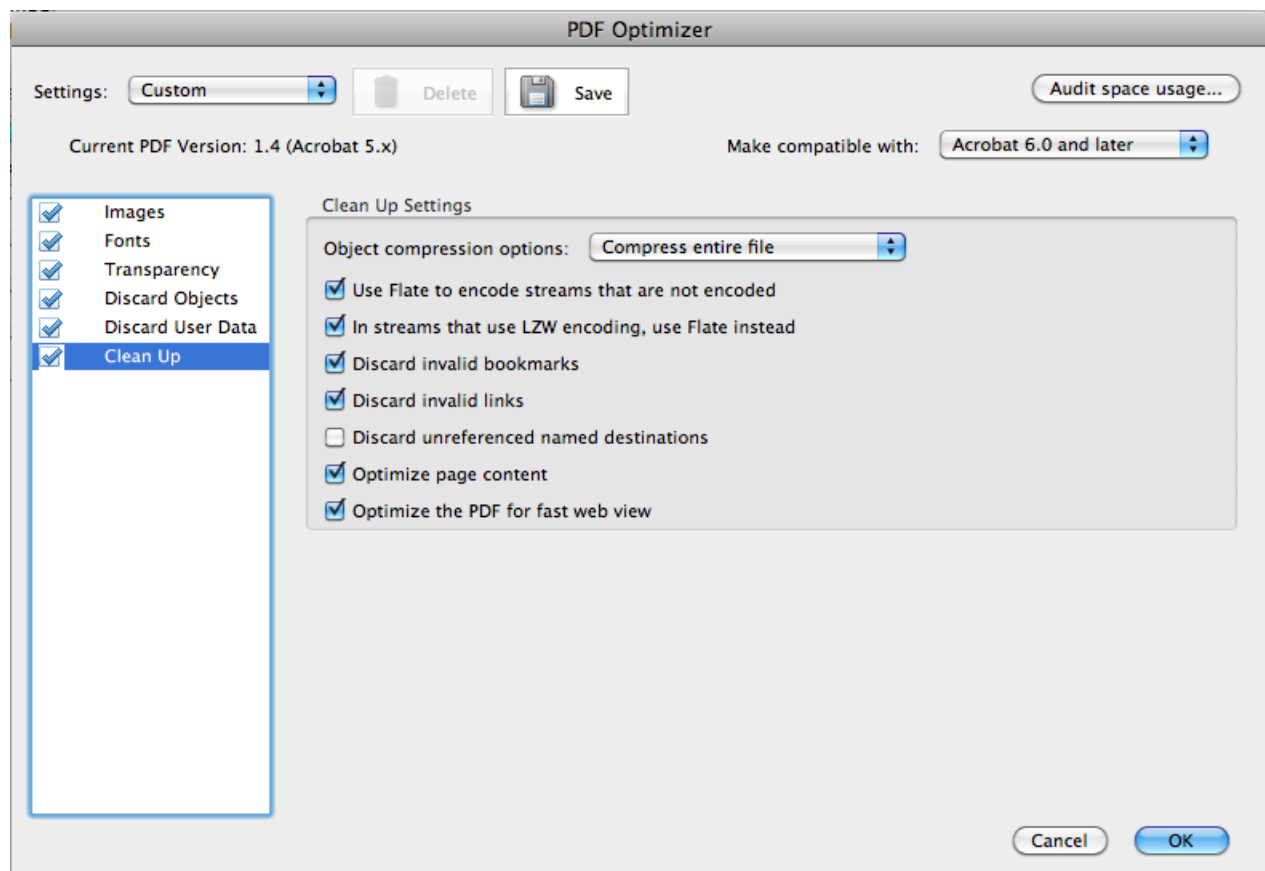
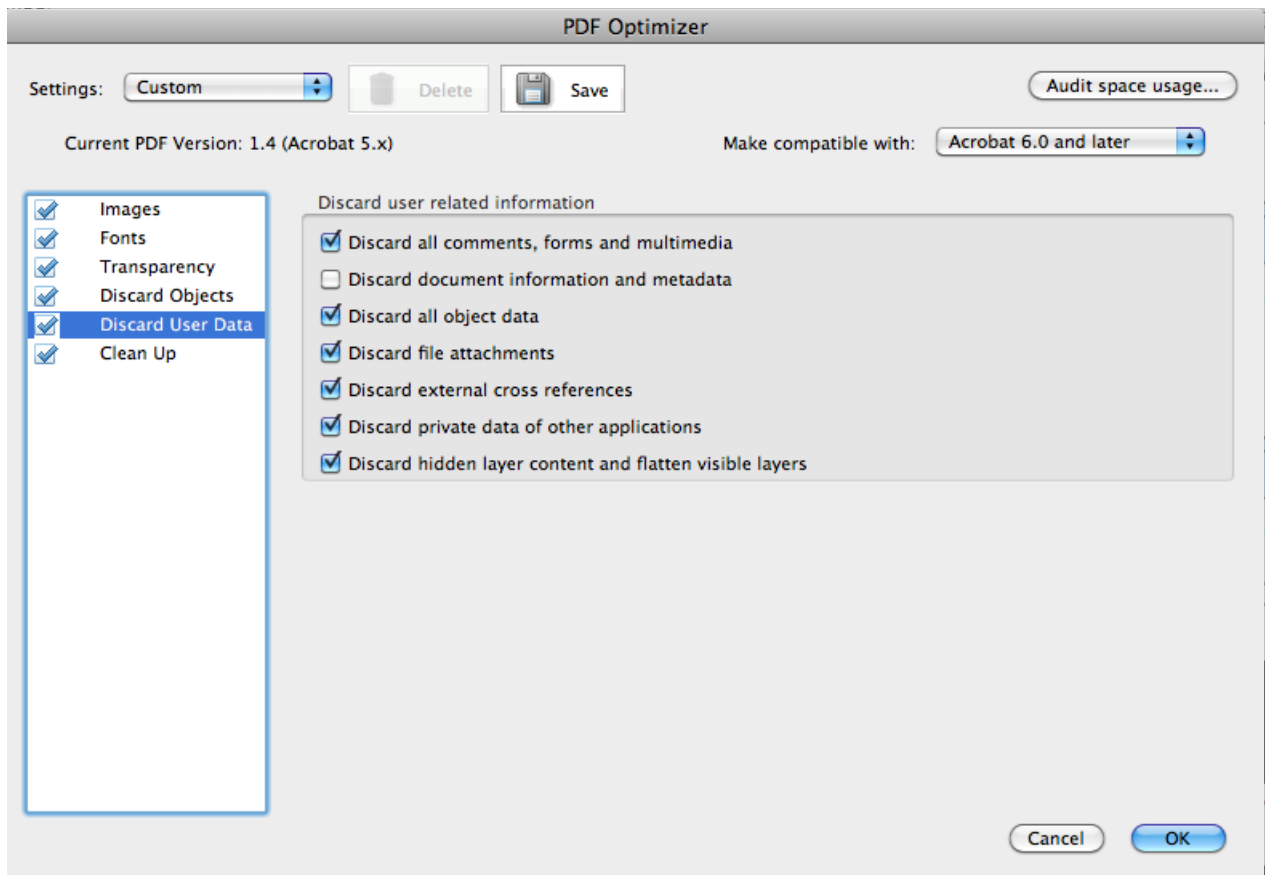
If your filesize is large—YES

What settings should I use?







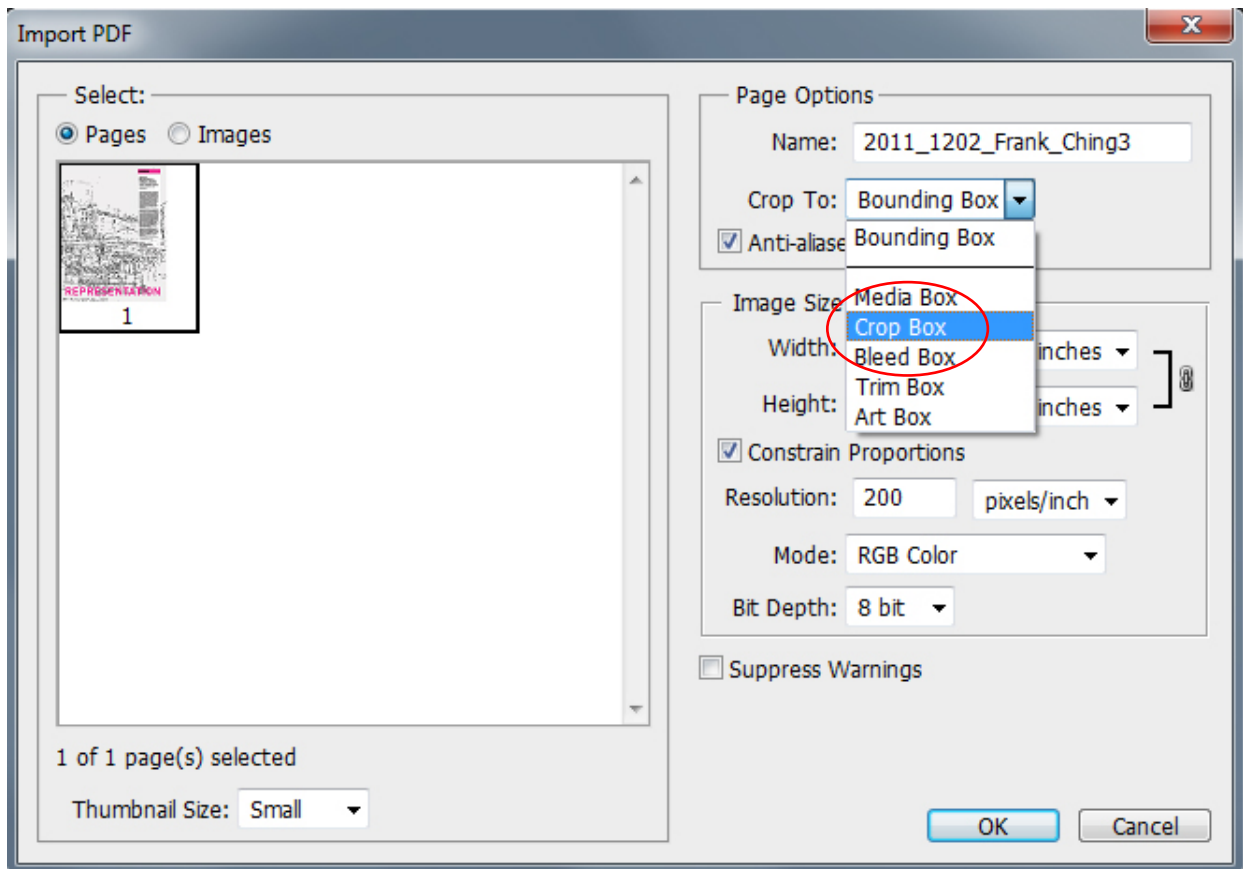
Does my file need to be rasterized?

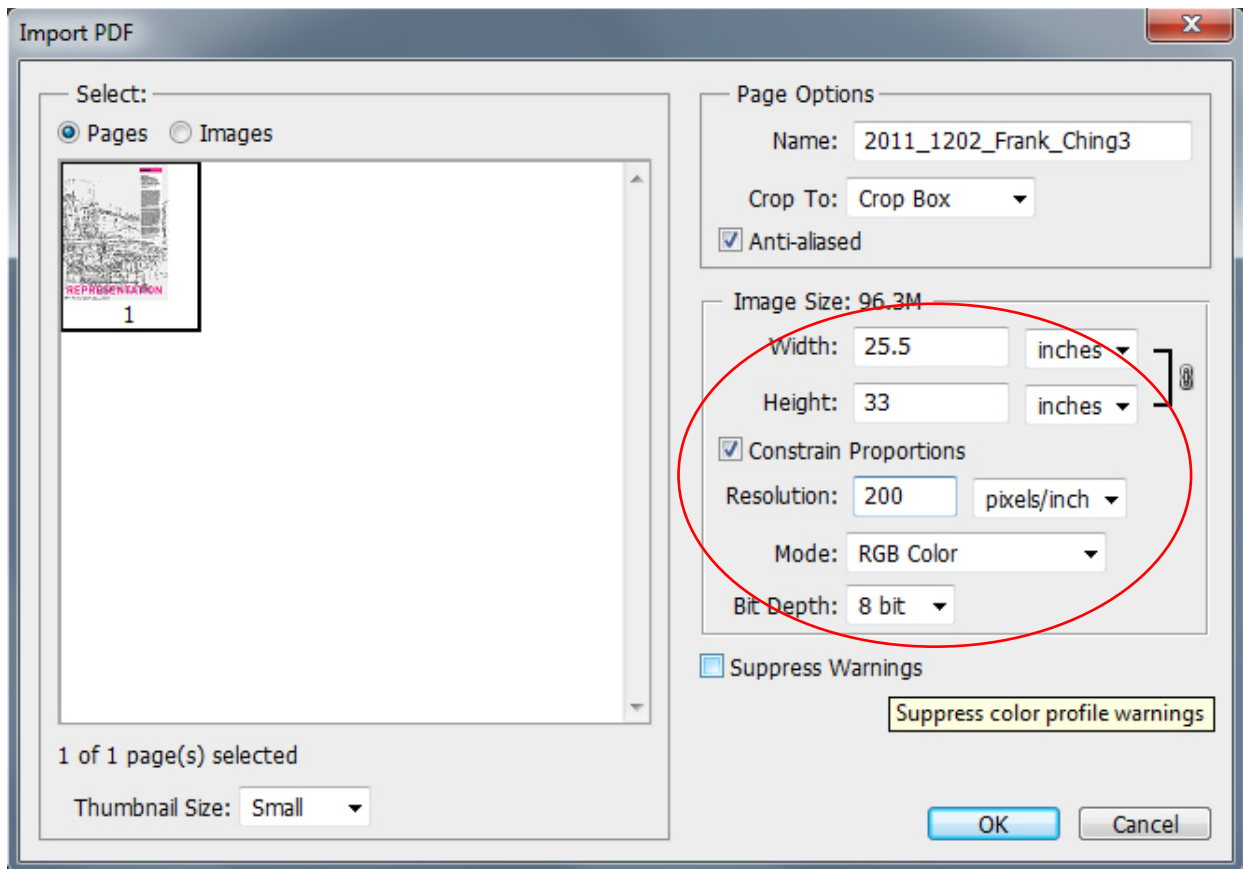
If your file refuses to print, even after optimization—**YES**

If your file includes transparency and optimizes poorly: you see boxes in areas where transparency is used (rasterize from your original UNoptimized file)—**YES**

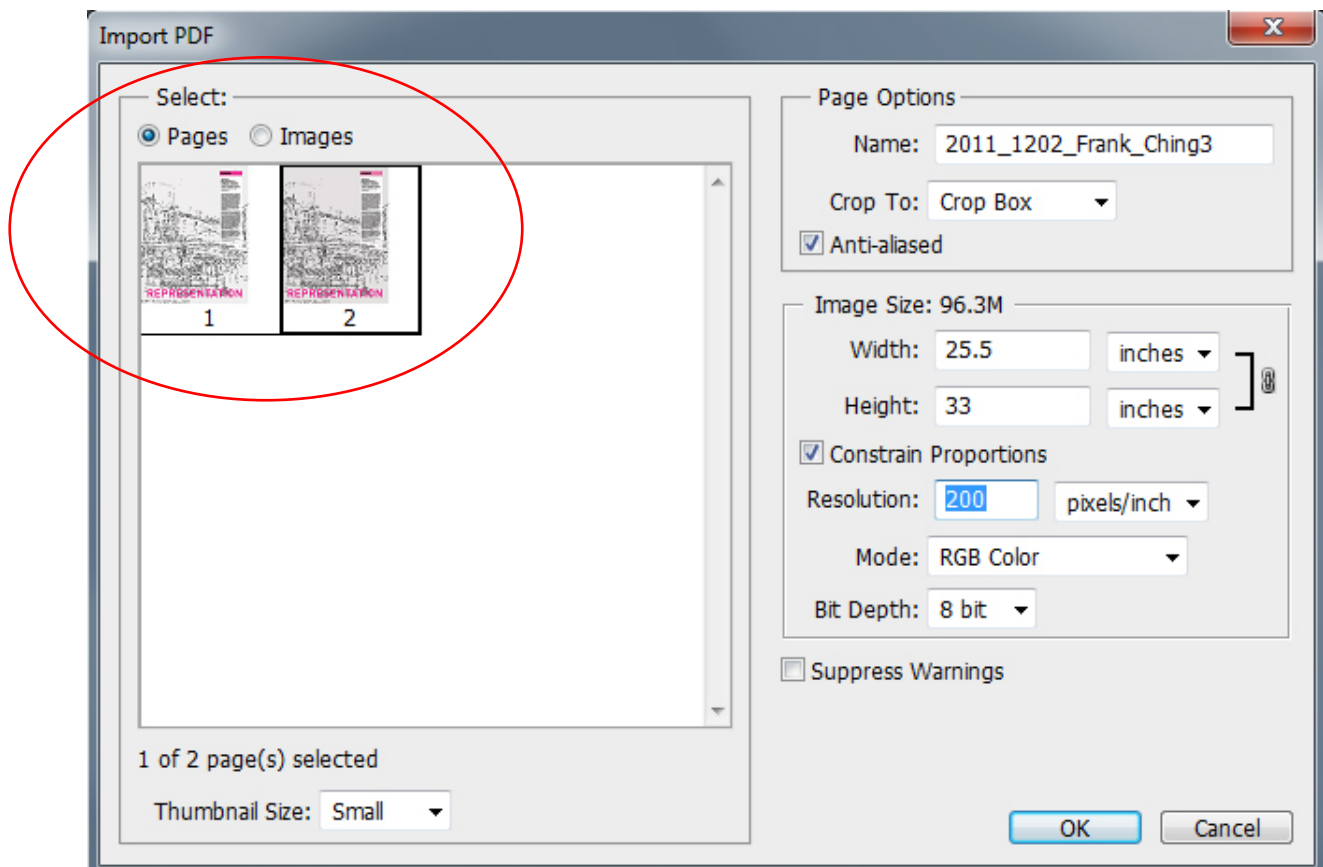
What settings should I use?

From within Adobe Photoshop, choose File->Open and select your file.





If your file contains multiple pages:



When done, please flatten your file (Layer->Flatten Image) and save.
